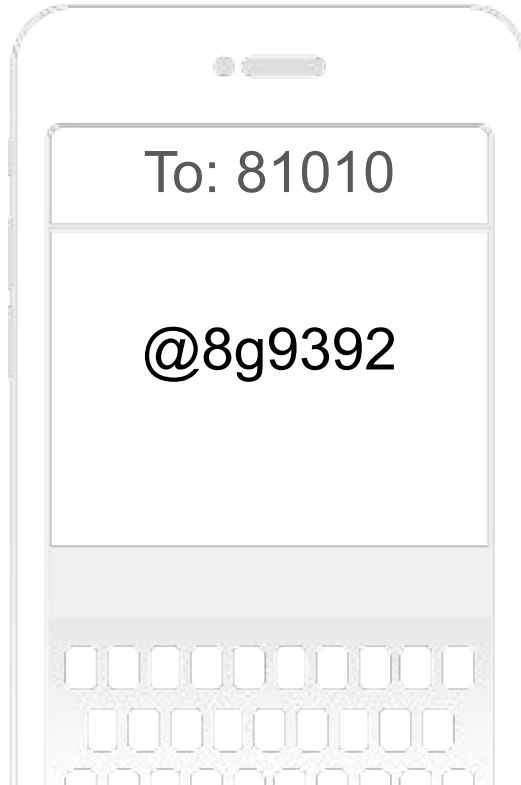

Park Expectations

- Band/School identifiable shirts at all parks
- Shenanigans show shirt for the workshop day
- Be in groups of 4 at all times
- Parent station at the front of each park when we're there
- Pay attention to your Remind
- Stay with the schedule - same as on a performance trip. We are traveling with a lot of people. Don't be the problem for everyone else.
- Being "stuck" in a line for a ride is no excuse for missing your report times or responding to your chaperone
- Someone in your group needs to have battery on their phone at all times (good idea to bring a portable battery charger & cord to keep in your backpack-do not put a portable battery in your checked baggage. It must go in your carry on)

Rules and Guidelines



- Normal school/band expectations to follow. It's a band trip and just because there is no performance we expect the same behavior.
 - Appropriate behavior (noise in the hotel or being disruptive in the park, PDA and so on)
 - No boys in girls rooms and no girls in boys room
 - Tobacco, drugs, alcohol, vapes or any accessories associated with vape or drug use are all banned items/substances - Any vape in school is assumed to be a controlled substance and is considered as such to school administration
 - Violations of local and state laws become the responsibility of local authorities
 - There are no second chances - Be prepared to buy a last minute plane ticket home
 - You represent our community, school, and your family

Rules and Procedures

This cannot be stressed enough.

Behavior on an out of state trip is always a concern. Please treat the adults, who are working hard for you to have a great trip, with the respect owed to someone who is providing you a really great opportunity.

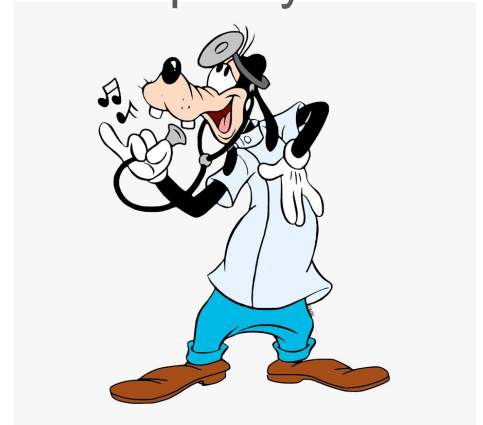
Have a good trip and have fun. But do not be a burden on other people. This includes our chaperones, park employees, or the general public. Be good people.

Medications

CFISD policy only FDA approved and regulated prescription medications can be administered to students by staff members. OTC medications and supplements are not FDA approved or regulated.

- Can be dropped off anytime staff members are on campus on **February 15**. The day before the departure day.
- Must have a new Medications Permission Form for this trip
- Must be dropped off by a parent/guardian
- Must be in the **original container and inside a ziplock bag with the student's name clearly labeled on the bag**. There's a band director on each flight and meds will travel with the flight group.
- **INCLUDE YOUR CHILD'S FLIGHT GROUP (A, B, or C, ON THE ZIPLOCK BAG!**

- We will, as always, carry the district provided generic benadryl, antacid, Tylenol, Advil
- Same as all band trips, announcements of meds availability will be in Remind

Air Travel

- Plan for entertainment that won't bother other passengers
- Be comfortable and dressed appropriately
- Don't wander the plane. Only up for RR
- Keep your area clean
- Southwest - Open seating
- United - Assigned seats
- Not a charter flight - Be considerate of other passengers
- Report any problems to your chaperone immediately - especially if it involves another passenger



Meals, Itinerary, and Spending Money

- Thursday - Eat breakfast before you come to school for the air travel or bring money to buy breakfast/snacks at the airport. Thursday is two provided meals only.
- Friday-Sunday - Breakfast at the hotel plus two meal vouchers each day. See the itinerary for full meal information.
- Monday - Breakfast at hotel -
 - Groups A and B - Lunch on your own - Save enough money to eat at the airport.
 - Group B - Lunch on your own at Disney Springs - Dinner on your own at airport.

Luggage

- One checked bag
- One carry on
- Backpacks are allowed in the park. They will be searched.
- Water tumbler that is easily carried and refillable. Bring a rain jacket or poncho.
- Pack lightly and make sure you include your Woods shirts for every day
- Don't forget your toiletries
